

DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tabunok, City of Talisay, Cebu

as of 17 July 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 June 2025, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Mananga II, Brgy. Tabunok, City of Talisay, Cebu. The fire was declared out at 3:45 PM. Several residential structures were destroyed, resulting in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) VII, in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of the City of Talisay, immediately provided food and non-food items (FNIs) as well as financial assistance (FA) to the affected families to address their urgent needs. II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **248 families** or **1,000 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tabunok, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **248 families** or **1,000 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Tabunok, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **248 houses** were damaged; of which, **232** are **totally damaged** and **16** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tabunok, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱8,899,943.25 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱5,209,943.25 from DSWD and ₱3,690,000.00 from the LGU (see Annex F).
