

## DSWD DROMIC Report on the Flooding Incidents in Dapa, Surigao del Norte

11 July 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 24 April 2025 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in the rest of Mindanao.

On the same day, several barangays in the municipality of Dapa, Surigao del Norte experienced flooding incidents due to heavy rainfall caused by ITCZ.
