

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Uson, Masbate

as of 02 August 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 July 2025 at around 5:46 AM, an armed conflict transpired between alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines - New People's Army (CPP-NPA) and the 2nd Infantry Battalion (IB) of the 9th Infantry Division (ID) of the Philippine Army (PA) in Brgy. Candelaria, Uson, Masbate.

The following day, on 20 July 2025, another encounter occurred between the alleged CPP-NPA members and the 21IB, 91D, PA military troops in Sitio Tisa, Brgy. Matagbac, Milagros, Masbate. On 27 July 2025, a firefight occurred between the same groups in Brgy. San Mateo, Uson, Masbate.

The series of crossfire incidents caused serious distress as well as the disruption to the daily living of the residents. In response, DSWD Field Office V provided relief assistance and conducted a psychological first aid for the affected population.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 1,010 families or 4,391 persons are affected in seven (7) barangays in Uson, Masbate (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 402 families or 1,430 persons currently taking temporary shelter in eight (8) evacuation centers in Uson, Masbate (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **37 families** or **106 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **439 families** or **1,536 persons** still displaced in **Uson**, **Masbate** (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}747,263.50\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}597,263.50\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}150,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex E).
