

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Clan Feud Incident in Brgy. Panadtaban, Rajah Buayan, Maguindanao del Sur

as of 01 August 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 08 July 2025 at around 7:10 PM, a clan feud or "rido" involving two (2) conflicting families transpired at Sitio Danasalan, Brgy. Panadtaban, Rajah Buayan, Maguindanao del Sur. The conflict resulted in the displacement of 1,050 individuals.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) XII, in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Rajah Buayan, Maguindanao del Sur, immediately provided family food packs (FFPs) to address the urgent needs of the affected individuals.

A total of **210 families** or **1,050 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Panadtaban**, **Rajah Buayan**, **Maguindanao del Sur** (see Annex A).

There are **210 families** or **1,050 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P122,379.60** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
