

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur

as of 06 August 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued at 4:00 AM on 03 August 2025, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms which may have caused possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day, Barangays Upper and Lower Timonan in Dumingag experienced heavy rainfall and strong winds due to a localized thunderstorm, resulting in damage to several houses in the nearby area. Affected families opted to seek temporary shelter with relatives or friends.

In response to these incidents, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region IX, provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 16 families or 80 persons are affected in two (2) barangays in Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **16 families** or **80 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 16 houses were damaged; of which, two (2) are totally damaged and 14 are partially damaged in Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P50,560.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
