

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Santa Cruz, Davao del Sur

as of 12 August 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 11 August 2025 at 4:00 PM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms which may have caused possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms in the rest of the country.

On the same day, Barangays Zone IV and Sinoron in Santa Cruz, Davao del Sur experienced flooding and landslide due to continuous heavy rainfall brought about by localized thunderstorms.
