

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 160, Caloocan City as of 05 August 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 July 2025 at around 1AM, a fire incident occurred at Libis Baesa, Brgy. 160, Caloocan City. The fire was declared out at around 3:04 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **65 families** or **275 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 160, Caloocan City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **65 families** or **275 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Hall** in **Brgy. 160, Caloocan City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **22 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 160, Caloocan City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱153,615.80** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
