

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 160, Caloocan City

as of 06 August 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 August 2025 at around 10:39 PM, a fire incident occurred at East Libis Baesa, Brgy. 160, Caloocan City. The fire was declared out on 03 August at around 2:27 AM.

A total of **75 families** or **260 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 160**, **Caloocan City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **75 families** or **260 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy**. **160 Multipurpose Hall** in **Caloocan City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 23 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 160, Caloocan City (see Annex C).
