

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Bañadero, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental

as of 03 August 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 April 2025 at around 3:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3 Brgy. Bañadero, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 4:30 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **nine (9) families** or **22 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Bañadero, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **nine (9) families** or **22 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **nine (9) houses** were damaged; of which, **seven (7)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Bañadero, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱92,508.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱47,508.00** from **DSWD** and **₱45,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
