

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Carangan, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental as of 04 August, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 April 2025 at around 3:54 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3A Brgy. Carangan, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 4:30 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **two (2) families** or **10 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Carangan, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **two (2) families** or **10 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Carangan, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱25,836.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱15,836.00** from **DSWD** and **₱10,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
