

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cavinte, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental

as of 09 August 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 March 2025 at around 10:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Cavinte, Ozamis City. The fire was declared out at around 11:05 PM.

One (1) family or five (5) persons are affected in Brgy. Cavinte, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or five (5) persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Cavinte, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P17,918.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **P7,918.00** from **DSWD** and **P10,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex D).
