

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Gibacungan, Tabango, Leyte as of 02 August 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 July 2025 at around 9:45 AM, a fire broke out in Brgy. Gibacungan, Tabango, Leyte. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the scene and extinguished the fire by 12:30 PM. Several residential structures were completely destroyed, displacing six (6) families who had sought temporary shelter at the Barangay Health Center in Brgy. Gibacungan. No injuries or casualties were reported.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in Region VIII, in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Tabango, Leyte, provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the affected families.

A total of **six (6) families** or **23 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Gibacungan, Tabango, Leyte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **six (6) families or 23 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Health Center** in **Brgy. Gibacungan, Tabango, Leyte** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **six (6) houses** were damaged; of which, **three (3)** were **totally damaged** and **three (3)** were **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Gibacungan, Tabango, Leyte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱50,346.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
