I. Situation Overview

On 05 August 2025 at around 4:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Fernando, Basey, Samar. The fire was declared out at around 5:08 PM.

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. San Fernando, Basey, Samar (see Annex C).
