

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Solinog, Calamba, Misamis Occidental

as of 04 August 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 April 2025 at around 11:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 4, Brgy. Solinog, Calamba, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 11:54 PM.

One (1) family or two (2) persons are affected in Brgy. Solinog, Calamba, Misamis Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or two (2) persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Solinog, Calamba, Misamis Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P27,918.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **P7,918.00** from **DSWD** and **P20,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex D).
