

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Pinguiaman, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat as of 09 August 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 08 August 2025 at 6:00 AM, the weather report indicated partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms, attributed to the prevailing Southwest Monsoon.

On the same day, one (1) barangay in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat experienced a flash flood due to heavy rainfall brought by the Southwest Monsoon.

Relative to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region XII, actively engaged in the response operation and closely coordinated with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Lambayong for timely updates and to address any potential requests for relief augmentation.
