

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Strong Wind Incident in Brgy. Aguada, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental as of 09 August 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On January 14, 2025, at around 6:00 PM, Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms, brought about by the Easterlies, might have brought flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the rest of the country. On the same day, a strong wind incident associated with the prevailing effects of the Easterlies occurred in Brgy. Aguada, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental, where a tree fell and completely destroyed a residential structure.

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Aguada, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex A).

One (1) house was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Aguada, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱10,622.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱622.00** from **DSWD** and **₱10,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
