

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Strong Wind Incident in Brgy. Carmen Annex, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental

as of 09 August 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 April 2025 at around 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms may have brought flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms caused by easterlies. On the same day, a strong wind incident, caused by easterlies, occurred in Brgy. Carmen Annex, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental, resulting in damage to properties.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) X, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental, provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the affected families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or five (5) persons are affected in Brgy. Carmen Annex, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}10,622.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, \$\mathbb{P}622.00\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}10,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex B).
