

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Strong Wind Incident in Brgy. Kinuman Sur, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental

as of 09 August 2025, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On April 26, 2025, at around 4:00 PM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms, brought about by the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ), might have brought flash floods or landslides due to moderate to heavy rains in Mindanao. On the same day, a strong wind incident associated with the prevailing effects of the ITCZ occurred in Brgy. Kinuman Sur, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental, where a tree fell and completely destroyed a residential structure.
