

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City as of 07 August 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 August 2025 at around 9:47 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 4:11 PM.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in the National Capital Region (NCR) is closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Manila City, for updates and requests for relief augmentation for the affected individuals and continuously gathering data on the total number of damaged houses.

A total of **865 families** or **3,460 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **865 families** or **3,460 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **865 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
