

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Bañadero, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental

05 September 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 18 April 2025 at around 3:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3 Brgy. Bañadero, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 4:30 PM. Due to the incident, 22 individuals were affected and caused significant damage to nine (9) residential houses.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in Region X, in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental, provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **nine (9) families** or **22 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Bañadero, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **nine (9) families** or **22 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **nine (9) houses** were damaged; of which, **seven (7)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Bañadero, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱92,508.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱47,580.00** from **DSWD**, and **₱45,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
