

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Pinguiaman, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat

26 December 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

Issued on 08 August 2025 at 6:00 AM, the weather report indicated partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms, attributed to the prevailing Southwest Monsoon (SWM).

On the same day, one (1) barangay in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat experienced a flash flood due to heavy rainfall brought by the SWM.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) XII, in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat, immediately provided family food packs (FFPs) to address the urgent needs of the 1,844 affected individuals.

A total of **439 families** or **1,844 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Pinguiaman, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat** (see Table 1).
